Navajo DOJ's Response to Court Filing by IDSA

WINDOW ROCK, NAVAJO NATION – February 11, 2026 - The Navajo Department of Justice was made aware on February 10, 2026 of a complaint filed by Indigenous Design Studio + Architecture, LLC (IDSA) against ZenniHome, LLC (ZenniHome) in Maricopa County Superior Court. IDSA and ZenniHome received a total of approximately \$24 million dollars from the Navajo Nation to build and deliver housing unit to residents of the Navajo Nation. Even though IDSA and ZenniHome received the \$24 million dollars, they have failed to deliver any completed housing units to the Navajo Nation. The complaint alleges that ZenniHome misspent the money that IDSA provided to ZenniHome.

“The Navajo Nation Department of Justice is working aggressively to pursue remedies against IDSA and ZenniHome,” stated Acting Attorney General Beecher in response to receiving the complaint filed by IDSA. “Both of these entities owe the Nation substantial sums related to the non-delivery of purchased housing units. IDSA’s decision to file litigation in Arizona state court will not change the Nation’s rights, which the Nation’s Department of Justice will continue to pursue. While we continue our work we are unable to comment further on litigation and pending litigation.”

The Navajo DOJ has been working diligently to investigate and address this matter since it was informed that IDSA was not meeting its housing production deadlines.
